NutrEvent's 8th edition will take place for the first time in Nantes in the Pays de la Loire Region, on October 4th and 5th and continue online on October 11th. The European event dedicated to innovation in Food, Feed, Nutrition and Health will focus on the latest trends and challenges these fields are facing. The sector must adapt to conscious consumerism and its best tool to do so is innovation.

NutrEvent, Europe's nerve system for innovation in the nutrition sector

Since its first edition in 2009, NutrEvent has grown to become a global hub in Europe for innovation regarding food, feed, nutrition and health industries. The event now relies on 3 competitive locations, Lille, Rennes and Nantes. During those three days, ingredient suppliers and distributors, finished food products and food supplement industries, academic stakeholders, R&D services and consulting firms will meet and seize opportunities. NutrEvent facilitates innovation through four means: an exhibiting area, some pitches sessions, a partnering platform and a conference programme. More than 500 delegates from over 25 countries will attend NutrEvent this year.

A conference programme in line with the sector's evolution

NutrEvent's programme is built around 3 tracks covering the innovation trends in food supplement, finished food products and the feed sector.

The two plenary sessions will address overarching issues of the sector, including the evolving consumer's vision. As consumers are more and more conscious of the links between, nutrition, health and ecology, the first plenary will elaborate on the concrete consequences of this phenomenon during the innovation process. The second one will focus on the conciliation between the industrial production of food products and the market's evolution towards a more and more personalised diet.

The conference programme will bring together international leading experts to share their thoughts on these topics during two days of top-notch panel discussions.

The Pays de la Loire Region

The **Pays de la Loire Region** ranks in the first place of France's regions for its quality of life. It is accessible and open to France and the world. The region is also very dynamic, thanks to a dense economic network and the diversity of its productive activities.

The food industry is a pillar of the economy in Pays de la Loire and is the main industrial employer in the region. This sector is characterized by a dense network of SMEs and major groups (such as Eurial, Charal, LU, Lactalis, Yoplait, Tipiak, Fleury Michon). As the 4th largest agricultural region in France, its agricultural resources are diversified and committed (more than 360 products under official quality label). The Pays de la Loire region offers more than 60 training courses dedicated to the food processing industry, from the CAP to the doctorate, and brings together more than 2000 students and 400 researchers.

The Region has developed an ecosystem of excellence dedicated to the food of tomorrow, around efficient networks (research centers, laboratories, competitiveness clusters, innovation platforms, business accelerators and associations), but also through the **Technocampus Alimentation**. This initiative, supported by the Region, is led by a team of experts in agri-food subjects and business support. The services offered are designed to provide concrete help to agri-food companies in Pays de la Loire, whatever their size, their project and the problems they face.

Nantes Metropole

Nantes Metropole, European capital of innovation in 2019, leads a proactive policy in favor of the strategic economic sectors of its territory, in particular the food sector and the health sector, with the aim of boosting the local innovation ecosystem.

In this context, Nantes Metropole supports the development of the "Atlanpole Biotherapies" competitiveness clusters for health and "Valorial" for food and provides financial support to the NEXT project for research and training in "health of the future" of the University of Nantes, Nantes University Hospital and INSERM as well as research projects on food allergies at INRAE in Nantes.

The Nantes area also has a Human Nutrition Research Center, very high-level research laboratories on the intestinal microbiota and research centers within IFREMER on algae and micro-algae.

Nantes Métropole displays a strong metropolitan ambition in favor of the "Health of the future" through several major structuring projects for the territory such as the creation of a future "Health district" on the island of Nantes bringing together both activities care, research, higher education and innovation with the construction of the new university hospital in 2027 with a budget of more than 1.2 billion euros.
